Guidelines for Counting Faculty Load Hours at JBU Last updated July 2025

1) **REGULAR COURSES** (most courses fit under this category)

- a. Regular course = student credit hours
- b. Regular course with 1-3 students = no load (taught as I.S.) (Colleges can opt to pay for the course)
- c. Regular courses that are team-taught = divide up the student credit hours equally
- d. Regular courses with contact hours greater than student credit hours (such as labs) = 2/3 of total contact hours. The total for a course may not exceed twice the student credit hours.
- e. OLUG/GR Managed Curriculum: Faculty load = 2.5 per 3 student credit hour Note:
 - TUG courses with enrollments under 8 will result in a charge to the college ancillary budget.
 - TUG courses offered as pilots or off-schedule (as per catalog) will be charged to the ancillary budgets.
 - OLUG courses and graduate business courses with managed curriculum with enrollments under 8 will result in pro-rated load and pay.

2) **DIRECTED LEARNING COURSES** (practica, internships, masterclasses, workshops, research, field experience, etc.)

- a. Directed learning course that meets regularly: follow guidelines for "Regular courses"
- b. Directed learning course that does not meet regularly = 1 credit of faculty load for 10 hours of student credit load (minimum of 4 students, load rounded up to nearest 0.5, maximum load = Student credit hours; in the case of variable credit courses, the maximum is the average number of student credit hours). Fewer than 4 students should be taught as IS, similar to the Regular Course rules.
- c. Graduate Counseling practicum = 4 hours of load per course section (max 6 students); individual clinical supervision is provided by the faculty member/course instructor. Graduate Counseling internship = 3 hours of load per Internship I/Internship II cross-listed course sections (max 12 students); individual clinical supervision is provided by the site.
- d. School Counseling practicum and internships = 0.33 credits per student. This is the total count of students in all practicum and internships under a given faculty member.
- e. Nursing Clinical Supervision = 1.33 hours of load per 3 hours of clinical supervision per week (this is generally 1 student credit hour) per section of 8 students.
- f. Nursing Precepted Practicums (NUR 4226) = 1 hour of load per 3 students.

3) SUPERVISED INSTRUCTION

- a. Student teaching = 0.67 hours load credit per student supervised
- b. Private Music Lessons = 0.33 hours load credit per 1.0 student credit. Each instructor receives 0.33 per semester for Masterclass.

Department Chair Load

Criteria for assigning TUG department chair load:

- 3 hours load and 2 steps if either of the following are true:
 - o The number of full-time faculty FTE plus an adjunct adjustment is greater than or equal to 5.
 - The adjunct adjustment is 0.5 FTE for every 3 distinct on-campus undergraduate adjuncts (averaged over the last three years)
 - The average on-campus undergraduate SSCH over the last three years is greater than 3000.
- 2 hours load and 1 step if either of the following are true:
 - o The number of full-time faculty FTE plus an adjunct adjustment is 3 or 4.
 - The adjunct adjustment is 0.5 FTE for every 3 distinct on-campus undergraduate adjuncts (averaged over the last three years)
 - The average on-campus undergraduate SSCH over the last three years is greater than 1500.
- 1 hour load and 0.5 step if either of the following are true:
 - o The number of full-time faculty FTE plus an adjunct adjustment is 2 or 1.
 - The adjunct adjustment is 0.5 FTE for every 3 distinct on-campus undergraduate adjuncts (averaged over the last three years)
 - o The average on-campus undergraduate SSCH over the last three years is greater than 1000.
